FIELD TRIP ITINERARY (9:30-11:30)

Des Moines County Heritage Center Museum

- 1. Students must be divided into six (6) groups with names submitted to DMCHS by email one (1) week before field trip. (Students should know their group number before arrival.
- 2. Begin the visit at the bottom of Snake Alley if weather and time permits.
- 3. Hike up the alley, turn right and walk down the two blocks to the <u>lower level</u> <u>Columbia Street</u> entrance to the museum.
- 4. Before entering the museum at 9:30, organize students into their six (6) groups with an adult chaperone assigned to each group. (All other adults are considered regular paying visitors (\$6 each) and need to use front entrance on N. 4th Street.
- 5. Individual personalized student Passports will be issued after entering the museum. There will be a different color for each group.
- 6. Students will be seated on the classroom floor in their group/color rows. The orientation session will be an introduction to why and how to add stickers to their passports.
- 7. During student orientation, chaperones will adjourn to receive timers and tour instructions.
- 8. Chaperones will monitor student behaviors, track with timers and hand out stickers. Museum docents will provide instruction.
- 9. Return to the classroom at end of tour and sit in circles. The Snake Alley sticker will be issued and small group discussion may occur while waiting for an 11:30 dismissal.
- 10. Chaperones will give instruction for dismissal. Students will keep their passports as a souvenir to use as a free pass for a return visit to the Heritage Center Museum with an adult.
