Town Hall Lectures

Every First Saturday of the Month (12:00 p. m.—3:00 p. m.)

Every first Saturday of the month, the Heritage Center will host a speaker, historian, or lecturer to give a presentation to the community about a particular topic related to Burlington or Des Moines County. This program will be typically free for patrons, the only time admission is charged for this program is for *special* lectures. Each participating patron will get a sticker from our museum staff that allows them free admission all day at the Heritage Center.

Miss Lillys' Story Time for Toddlers

Feb 18, March 25, and April 22 from (10:00 a. m.)

This program is hosted by the Burlington Public Library and is free to families who participate in story times, activities, and playtime in Catfish Corner. Each participating patron will get a sticker from our museum staff that allows them free admission all day at the Heritage Center.

Sounds of the Past

Every Third Saturday of the Month (10:00 a. m.—12:00 p. m.)

Colton Neely, Executive Director, will be performing ragtime tunes on the historic Martin Bruhl Steinway Piano in the main atrium. Patrons are required to pay general admission and will have a chance to wander the Heritage Center, make requests to the pianist for reproduction sheet music published in Des Moines County, and hear live demonstrations of various musical devices within our new Burlington Music Exhibit.

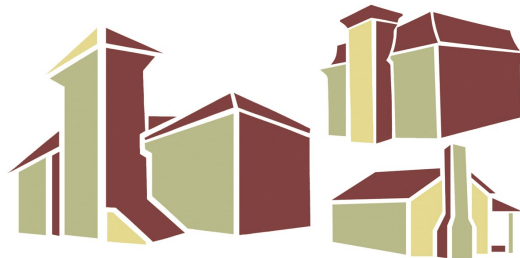
